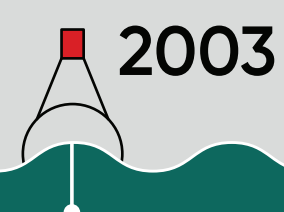


About Us

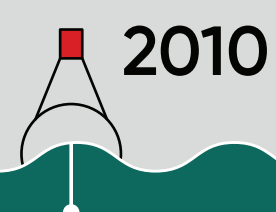
Our History

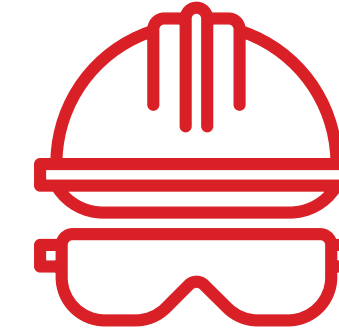

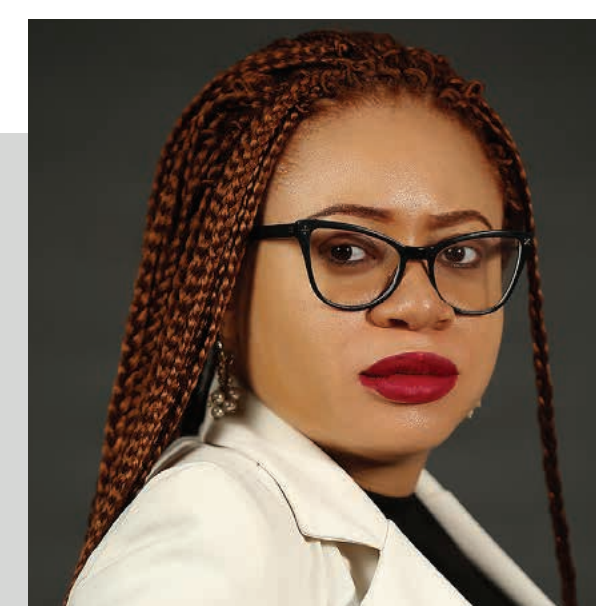
He has a Masters degree in Shipping Management from the Rivers State University and a Bachelors degree in Mechanical Engineering from the Rivers State University of Science and Technology.






